Please also note that:

One course in the student's program must fulfill the Intercultural Interconnecting Perspectives requirement.

One course in the student's program must fulfill the Communication Mode of Inquiry requirement.

A total of 124 hours are required for graduation; 40 of these hours must be completed in 300 level or above courses.

A 2.0 cumulative GPA and a 2.0 major GPA is necessary to graduate with a History major.
